

UAF Special Academic Program Review 2014 -2015 Final Cabinet Decisions

The following changes are the result of an extensive academic special review process which examined programs selected for review based on the following criteria:

- Being among the lowest enrollment programs of their type

 - o Certificate, associate, baccalaureate, graduate

- Decreasing enrollment of more than 30 percent in the past five years

- Being among the lowest number of graduates in the past three years for programs of their type

As required by UAF's accrediting organization, UAF will make arrangements for all currently enrolled students to complete their programs in a timely fashion. Affected students are encouraged to work closely with an advisor to develop a plan to complete their degrees and certificates. UAF still maintains more than 180 programs to provide a
